- Executive Session: The executive session that was originally scheduled to occur was canceled.
- **2. June 16, 2023 HCRSD Board Meeting Minutes:** *Motion made by Bill Byrd, second by Charlie Crawford, to approve the meeting minutes. Motion approved unanimously.*
- **3. Insurance:** Pam Bennett Martin presented a summary of the District's current coverage and limits. A brief discussion was held regarding the premiums and items covered.
- 4. Lanesville Interchange (Future READI Project): Darrel Voelker informed the Board on Monday July 17, 2023 their \$1M request submitted last month was approved. As a reminder these funds are for a sewer extension project to serve the remaining properties around the north side of the interchange (areas along Peter Schickle Way and Old Lanesville Rd). There is currently \$500k in READI grant funding available that must be matched by a \$500k commitment from the District. Funds must be utilized and spent by

December 31, 2026. A decision on moving forward with this project will need to be made at some point in the near future. The Board discussed the matching funds would need to come from the County. No further action was taken.

5. Berkshire WWTP:

a. Operations Report (June): Aaron Tolliver presented the June operations report. All parameters were met for the month of June. Aaron pointed out to the Board on June 25 & 26 the flows from the mobile home park's influent flow meter show a spike in flows. There were rain events on both of those days: 2 inches on June 25, and 1.5 inches on June 26 were recorded at the rain gauge at the WWTP. A motion was made by Dan Lee, second by Tony Combs, to accept the June operations report. Motion approved unanimously.
